The Board of County Commissioners of Chippewa County, Minnesota, met in regular session on Tuesday, May 4, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. in the courthouse in Montevideo, Minnesota. Commissioners present were Chairman, Mark Dahl, Jeffrey Lopez, Jim Dahlvang, Gene Van Binsbergen, and Kenneth Koenen.

The date for the next regular meeting was set for Tuesday, May 18, 2010 at 1:00 p.m.

The Chairman asked for any additions or deletions to the agenda. The Auditor/Treasurer reported that there would be two additional items for consideration, to amend the bid for the outdoor warning sirens opened on April 20, 2010 and to re-appoint Marv Garbe as representative to the Southwest Minnesota Emergency Medical Corporation Board of Directors. Upon a motion by Commissioner Koenen, second by Commissioner Dahlvang, to approve the agenda as amended. The motion passed by a unanimous vote.

Motion made by Commissioner Dahlvang, second by Commissioner Koenen, to approve the minutes of April 20 and 22, 2010 as amended. The motion passed by a unanimous vote.

County Attorney, Dwayne Knutsen gave the Board a report on the activities in his office and also updated them on court trials and investigations.

County Sheriff, Stacy Tufto met with the Board to review the activities of his department during the month of April 2010. Sheriff Tufto requested authorization for an expenditure in the amount of \$15,160 to GeoComm for a software upgrade to the mapping software used in the dispatch area. The expenditure was authorized as requested by the Sheriff.

County Engineer, Steve Kubista met with the Board to review the activities in his department during April 2010. Mr. Kubista requested approval of a resolution requesting authorization from the State of Minnesota to advance 2011 state aid construction funds to 2010. Upon a motion by Commissioner Koenen, second by Commissioner Lopez, to approve the following resolution:

Land & Resource Management Director, Scott Williams met with the Board to discuss correspondence received from the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency indicating that the landfill must apply for a storm water management permit. Mr. Williams is recommending that Liesch & Associates be engaged to complete the application for an estimated fee of \$2,494. Upon a motion by Commissioner Van Binsbergen, second by Commissioner Dahlvang, to authorize Mr. Williams to complete an agreement for Liesch and Associates for the preparation of the permit. The date for the next regular meeting was set for Tuesday, June 1, 2010 at 9:00 a.m.

The Chairman asked for any additions or deletions to the agenda. The Auditor/Treasurer reported that Reed Molden will be unable to attend the meeting at 2:00 p.m. and that the Board will consider a contract amendment that would allow for a time extension to the Lac qui Parle Water Access Site Paving Project. Upon a motion by Commissioner Lopez, second by Commissioner Koenen, to approve the agenda as amended. The motion passed by a unanimous vote.

Motion made by Commissioner Lopez, second by Commissioner Koenen, to approve the minutes of May 4, 2010 as presented. The motion passed by a unanimous vote.

The Chairman asked for comments from the public who were present for the meeting. Hearing none the meeting continued.

Preservation District in Section 27 of Sparta Township. The Planning Commission is recommending approval of the CUP with conditions. Mr. Williams updated the Board on the progress of the permit application process for Duinick Bros., Inc. and the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency for a liquid cement/asphalt storage facility near Asbury. No action taken.

The Auditor/Treasurer reported to the Board changes made by the Minnesota legislature mandating that all counties in the State of Minnesota process absentee ballots using an Absentee Ballot Board. The legislation also requires the Board to appoint members to that board. The Auditor/Treasurer presented a resolution for consideration.
